



Women's Bible Study

Begin your study by asking God to reveal the message He wants you to understand in these chapters. Then using your bible cross-references, and word study to make your observations. Once that is done you may refer to Bible commentaries to understand any passages you are unsure of, then answer the following questions:

Observation:

1. Who are the main characters in these two chapters and what do you know about them so far?
2. Where do these stories take place? Look into the locations described and note their significance or history.
3. What do you observe about Abram's character, what is the evidence?
4. What do you observe about Lot's character, what is the evidence?
5. Do you see God favoring one over the other and what is His reaction?

Interpretation:

Where do you find a foreshadowing of Jesus in this text?

Application:

6. In what ways have you sought peace in the face on conflict?

7. Have you considered if your choices move you closer to God or closer to the world/cultural norms. Where do you pitch your tent? *Do not be deceived: ‘Bad company ruins good morals’” (1 Corinthians 15:33).*

8. Do you allow the allure of prosperity to lead you places where your soul or the souls of your family members are endangered?
